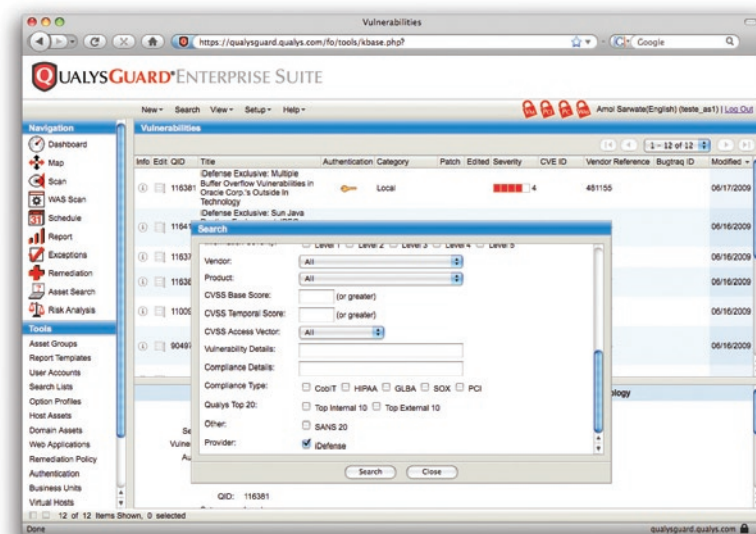


Figure 1: QualysGuard KnowledgeBase with iDefense Exclusives

- **Zero-day threat details are available in QualysGuard so customers can analyze their impact and put counter measures to protect their affected assets until a patch is available from the vendor.**

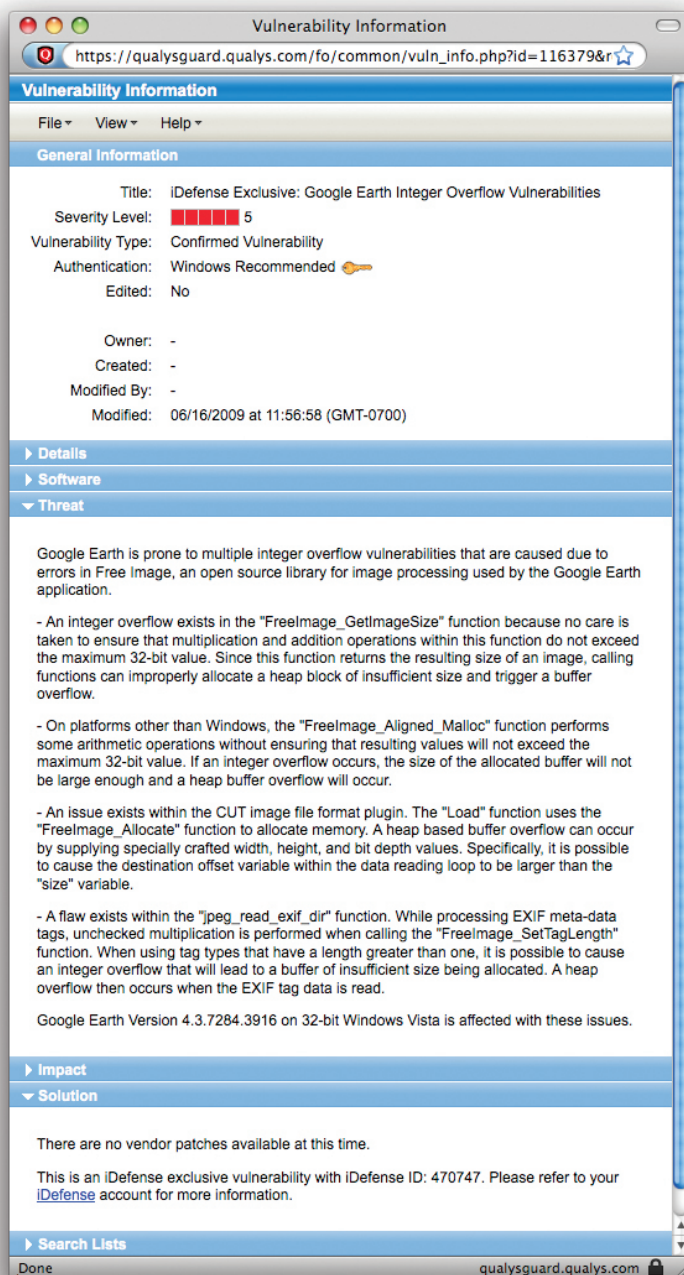


Figure 2: iDefense Exclusive Vulnerability in QualysGuard
